Key Messages for Team Members

- Thank you for all you're doing to help us supply safe, affordable, high-quality food to our customers and consumers.
- Our role as America's largest food company is critical, so we're working hard to make sure we continue producing the food people need during this challenging time.
- The food industry is recognized by the government as an essential part of our national infrastructure. It is vital that you come to work as planned, despite stories about "shelter in place."
- Your health and safety are very important to us.
- We will soon equip trained personnel with thermometers to take the temperature of every team member before each shift.
- Temperature is taken by scanning or touching the thermometer to the head. It will take less than a minute of your time to check your temperature each day.
- This is a safe and very important step intended to help make sure you and your co-workers remain healthy.
- If any team member has a temperature 100.4 °F or greater, they will not be permitted to enter the plant.
- We'll provide directions soon about how this will work at this location.
- Please be patient as we work through this process; we'll get through this together.
- We encourage everyone to take your temperature and your family's temperature each day before coming to work. If it's more than 100.4 degrees, please stay home.

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
